

10.1 Relationships with the Broader Educational and Training Community.

As the sole representative, coordinating, lobbying, training and support group for Irish Community Radio, Craol provides support to Craol stations throughout the country. Every week, across Ireland, 2000 Community radio volunteers broadcast to 170,000 people in 21 fully licensed stations and almost 30 aspirant stations. Craol is committed to developing and maintaining open and transparent communication between governance and local stations.

Craol does not deliver modules in partnership with any external agencies. Accredited QQI Craol modules are delivered by registered Craol trainers. Non QQI workshops are offered to station staff, volunteers and board members. Both QQI accredited modules and non-QQI accredited workshops are subject to the same rigorous quality assurance system to ensure best learning outcomes for learners and to uphold the quality assurance system of Craol.

10.2 External partnerships and second providers

10.3 Expert panellists, examiners and authenticators

The CCC is responsible for recruiting internal verifiers and external authenticators.

The Craol Project Coordinator carries out internal verification and verifies that all assessment procedures have been applied. Assessment results are monitored via a sample basis. A qualified external QQI approved authenticator authenticates the results by sampling learner evidence according to Craol's sampling strategy.
